

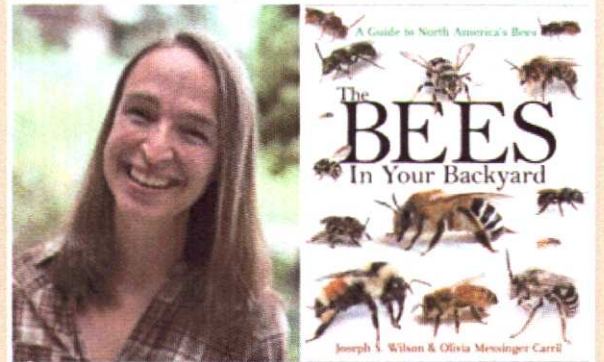
# Bees in Your Backyard
