It's time once again to make plans and you are cordially invited to participate in the Winter 2019 Ohio Maple Days Workshops in Morrow County Thursday January 17, or Holmes County Friday January 18, or Geauga County Saturday January 19. As is our custom, the same program will be offered at all three locations.

Topics To Be Covered:

FSMA Implementation Update: The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is implementing more portions of the Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) law. Producers will hear the latest sections of FSMA to be implemented in 2019 and the latest on Registration requirements.

Maple Research Update – The UVM Proctor Maple Research Center conducts a wide variety of research on topics related to maple sap collection, syrup production, tapping guidelines and sustainability, factors influencing the sap flow mechanism and sugar content, and tree health. This presentation will detail some of the recent findings of research and provide the opportunity for producers to ask questions.

Spout and Tubing Sanitation for 5/16" and 3/16" Tubing Systems -- Sanitation is a critical factor in achieving high sap yields. This talk will summarize a decade of research on spout and dropline sanitation effects on sap yield and net profit from tubing systems and introduce a model for producers to calculate the results of changes in sanitation regimens in their own operations.

Maple Nuggets: Every year there are lots of important updates and news to share with maple producers. These items will be addressed during this session as well as any questions submitted with the registration forms and not already answered by the speakers.

**** To Help Us Prepare **** we are asking that you pre submit your questions/concerns/ comments regarding any of the topics to be presented at the meetings (see back of the registration form). The meeting forum will allow for questions from the floor. Pre-submitting questions will direct the program to emphasize what questions you, the producers, have. Handouts will be made available to participants at the meetings in regards to the topics being covered. Pre-registration is required to ensure we have enough materials and meals.

Testing of Hydrometers & Refractometers: Hydrometers & refractometers are vital in every sugaring operation, so be sure they remain accurate. The papers can shift and readings will be off, which could result in finishing off too low of density and syrup could mold or ferment. If finished with too high of density, the syrup will crystallize. Bring your hydrometers with you to the meetings for testing; that way you know going into the 2019 season you will be finishing your syrup at the proper density.
