Come learn about stream life in the Shenango Wildlife Area along Pymatuning Creek Wild & Scenic River



Sunday, August 22, 2021, 1:00pm – 2:30pm: Join ODNR Division of Natural Areas & Preserves, the Division of Wildlife, Division of Parks & Watercraft, Trumbull SWCD, and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at the Village of Orangeville's Andy Dorick Park to learn about stream life in Pymatuning Creek Wild & Scenic River and in the Shenango Wildlife Area.

Come and see a fish shocking demonstration, various stream critters, and other educational information about recreation and conservation. Talk to fisheries biologists, Natural Resources Officers, conservation educators, and park rangers.
